Since then, Wohler Technologies has continued to extend its product line beyond its original creation. In 1997, the company introduced its video division, PANORAMAdtv, and began offering monitoring technology for video signals. Throughout the past twenty years, Wohler Technologies and PANORAMAdtv have continued to evolve with the needs of its customers, providing audio and video monitoring systems for analog, AES/EBU, HD/SD-SDI, Dolby Digital and Dolby E. Leading the industry with innovation and development, Wohler Technologies was the first to introduce monitoring solutions for SD-SDI, HD-SDI, and Dolby signals.

Today, the company operates in Hayward, CA under the direction of Chief Executive Officer, Carl J. Dempsey.
