PANORAMAdtv Introduces a Series of Professional High Definition LCD Monitors

New TFT LCD monitor solutions provide rack mount or table top replacements for CRTs

HAYWARD, CA – June 18, 2007 – In April, PANORAMAdtv, the video division of Wohler Technologies Inc., released a 1920 x 1080 native resolution, high definition, 17-inch, rack mountable LCD video monitor. In addition, the company also introduced an 8.4-inch HD/SD-SDI LCD video monitor. These units are the first in PANORAMAdtv's new HDMon series, providing space saving, environmentally friendly replacements for CRTs. Offering a slim, lightweight design, these units easily convert from a rack mount to a table top solution with minimal additional hardware.

The HDMon series of professional grade video monitors accept composite and component video, S-video, DVI, PC and have HD/SD-SDI video input with buffered loop-throughs. No options cards are required. The control settings are easily accessible from the front panel or can be configured remotely via a 10/100 Base-T connector and their included Windows-based GUI software application. This remote feature allows users to conveniently adjust and configure units as well as copy and paste setups from one monitor to another using a laptop or PC.

The **HDMon-170** is virtually the only completely HD, WUXGA capable, 17-inch rack mountable LCD monitor in the market. This unit delivers the same 132 square inch viewable screen as a 20-inch 16:9 CRT display in only 6RU of space. With a native resolution of 1920 x 1200 lines, this unit is an ideal solution for monitoring high definition signals. Exceeding most CRT monitors in horizontal and vertical resolution, the HDMon-170 provides true picture representation without extensive scaling and image manipulation.

The **HDMon-90** is an 8.4-inch HD/SD-SDI video monitor. Designed for field and studio applications, it has essential features for broadcast professionals, including user-adjustable scaling and motion interpolation, power-saving auto shut off, 4:3 or 16:9 aspect ratios and a high resolution screen. This compact, 4RU monitor, fits side-by-side in a standard rack or can be adapted for portable use.
